Interested in Becoming a Teen Leader?

Teen Leaders is a 4-H Club for teens ages 13-18 as of January 1st. It is a group that focuses on leadership training, team building, community service, and event planning. Teen Leaders provide the help and support for many of the county-wide activities that are held throughout the year. If you are someone who likes to help younger children, prepare for events, work on community service projects, and provide support from "behind the scenes", this is the club for you!

You will be required to take a Leadership project through Teen Leaders. We will work on the project as a group, but you will be required to go through an individual judging to complete the project. Completion of the project is required to successfully complete your year in Teen Leaders.

Carroll County Teen Leaders meet on the 1st Monday of the month at 4:30pm at the Extension Office. Depending on what activities, programs, and events are happening, there may be additional meetings throughout the month.
